



• POLITICAL CARTOONS •

- ✓ The finished product should consist of at least six political cartoons.
- ✓ Each cartoon should be reproduced with precision (no fuzzy images).
- ✓ No two cartoons may reflect the same historical period or movement.
- ✓ Accompany each cartoon with detailed description of the event portrayed, circumstances of the incident, causes and effects, key people involved, and identification of chief elements within the drawing (including what each component is intended to represent).
- ✓ State the overall message conveyed by the cartoonist.
- ✓ Arrange the images chronologically. One cartoon per page.
- ✓ Identify the original source (artist, publication, date) for each cartoon.
- ✓ It is acceptable to substitute a significant artwork for *one* of the cartoons.
- ✓ Pay special attention to accuracy, thoroughness, and presentation.
- ✓ Examples of dazzling work may be available from your instructor.

The primary objective for this and all APUSH activities is to intensify a portion of your personal preparation for the National Exam!
