1. Using your knowledge of United States history, answer parts a, b, and c.
 - a) Briefly explain why ONE of the following options exemplifies the historical legacy of the Federalists.
 - United States Constitution
 - Alexander Hamilton’s economic plan
 - George Washington’s “Farewell Address”
 - b) Provide ONE example of a specific event or development to support your explanation in (a) above.
 - c) Provide ONE example of a specific event or development which represents flaw or shortcoming on the part of the Federalists with the option you selected in (a) above.
