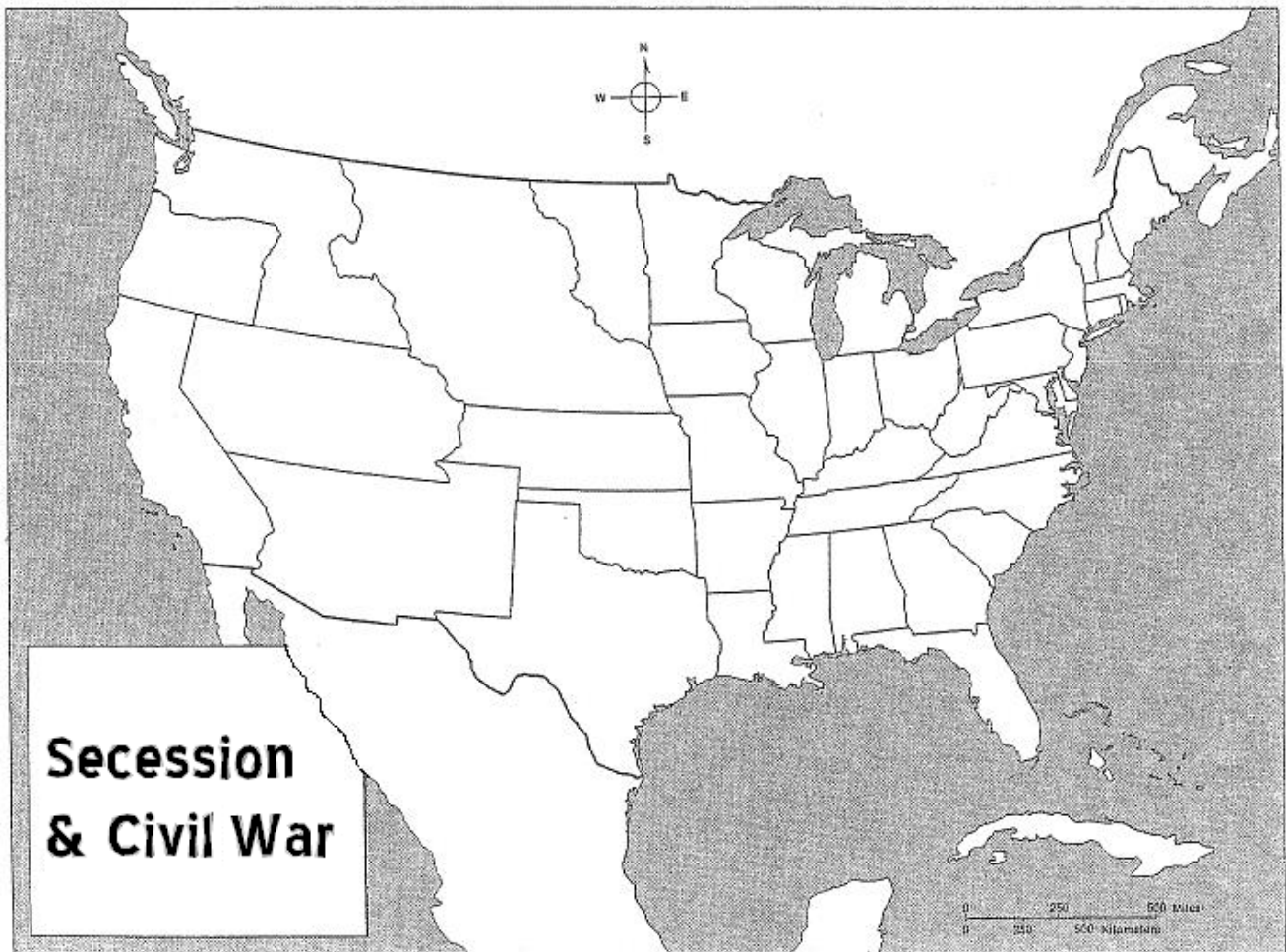


# Map Exercise: The Civil War

- The Civil War began in April of 1861, when Confederate forces levied a 35-hour bombardment on Fort Sumter. *Place the letters “FS” in the state where Fort Sumter is located.*
- Historians consider the military turning point of the Civil War to be the Battle of Gettysburg, fought in early July of 1863. It was General Robert E. Lee’s first clear defeat of the war. *Place the letter “G” in the northern state where this battle happened.*
- Another key victory for the North was the Vicksburg Campaign because it gave the Union control of the Mississippi River and led directly to the appointment of General Ulysses S. Grant as commander of the Army of the Potomac. Vicksburg took place simultaneously with Gettysburg. *Place the letter “V” in the southern state where the Vicksburg Campaign occurred.*
- In 1864, General William Tecumseh Sherman marched his Union force practically unopposed through the very heart of Dixie, engaging in “total war” as he advanced—destroying crops, killing livestock, burning buildings, dislodging railroad tracks. *Place the letter “S” in the southern state most affected by Sherman’s relentless “march to the sea.”*
- Imagine a Civil War battle that did not really occur. *Place the letters “DNAO” in the state you want your imaginary battle that never happened to actually not occur.*
